Dear ITServe Members and Teams,

As my term as National President of ITServe for 2023 draws to a close, I would like to take a moment to reflect on the extraordinary achievements of this year and extend my heartfelt gratitude to the dedicated teams and members who made it all possible. It has been a tremendous honor to work alongside Team 2023 and serve the ITServe community.

Chapters, Membership, Sponsorship, New Chapter Launches:

1.All 21 Chapters: Throughout the year, our chapters have remained active, vibrant, and highly productive. They have consistently conducted quality meetings, expanded their membership and sponsorship, and engaged in numerous CSR and PAC activities.

2.National Team Cooperation: The national team embarked on an extensive journey to visit all 21 chapters, fostering collaboration and strengthening our interconnected network.

3.Membership Growth: We enthusiastically welcomed over 780 new members, pushing our total membership count to an impressive 2,240.

4.Chapter Strength: Nine chapters achieved remarkable membership figures exceeding 100, with an additional 10 chapters reaching over 50 members. Special recognition goes to Dallas with 450+ members, North East with 250+, and Chicago and DMV with 150+ each. Atlanta, Austin, Bay Area, Detroit, and Houston all surpassed the 100-member mark.

5.New Chapter Launches: We proudly inaugurated two new chapters in Minneapolis and Maryland, expanding our footprint and outreach.

6.Membership Renewal: Our renewal rate soared to an impressive 95%, with 1,550 members renewing their memberships this year.

7.India Membership Team: A significant portion of the credit for managing both new memberships and renewals goes to our diligent India Membership Team.

8. New Annual Fee: A successfully implemented new annual fee structure introduced membership at \$500, CSR at \$200, and PAC at \$300.

9. Sponsorship Success: We reached unprecedented heights in Platinum and Grand Sponsorships with 2 Grand and 10 Platinum sponsors. Annual Chapter Sponsorship also achieved its pinnacle.

10. Pricing Strategy: We executed a new pricing strategy, resulting in price increases ranging from 40% to 100% in various packages.

11. India Team's Role in Sponsorship: The India Team played a pivotal role in managing all sponsorship contracts.

PAC/CPAC/CSR/YEP:

1. Advocacy and Legislation: Proactively advocating for our members, we filed litigation on 221 G and introduced the ITServe Bill – Hire Act. We also submitted critical comments on Fee Increases and New H1B rules.

2. Lobby Day Success: Our inaugural in-person Lobby Day was a resounding success, with over 160 meetings conducted by 200 dedicated ITServe members.

3. CSR Impact: Our CSR initiatives left an indelible mark, with 70 STEM scholarships awarded, veteran training programs established in 8 centers, and an astonishing 3,500+ hours of CSR volunteer work. Additionally, we conducted over 110 CSR activities and facilitated 6 internships.

4. YEP Milestone: We proudly marked a significant milestone by successfully completing two courses in our Young Entrepreneurs Program (YEP) for the first time.

Benefits/ITSS:

1. Insurance Partner: After rigorous research and evaluation, we selected an insurance partner expected to generate substantial income.

2. ADP Agreement: Our agreement with ADP is poised to generate over \$25,000 in income.

3. Membership Card: We introduced membership cards, which were efficiently distributed to all chapters.

4. Government MOUs: We cemented our partnerships by signing MOUs with the governments of Karnataka and Telangana for Tier 2 IT hubs.

5. Leadership and Training: Our commitment to leadership development led to the successful completion of leadership and sales training programs.

6. Marketplace Launch: The launch of our marketplace initiated the collection of valuable data.

7. GovCon Day: Our maiden GovCon day concluded successfully, adding another feather to our cap.

Startup/Technology/PR:

1. Startup Success: We celebrated three triumphant Startup Expos, including one at Synergy. The launch of ITServe Angels resulted in the funding of three companies, raising over \$5 million. Our network now boasts of 200+ angels.

2. Technology Advancements: Automation and productivity enhancements were achieved through the launch of a ticketing system, ITServe emails, and a pilot Expense Management system for multiple events.

3. PR Initiatives: With the hiring of a content writer, we elevated our PR efforts, maintaining regular newsletters, e-magazines, and press releases.

4. Media Presence: Multiple TV and radio interviews featuring National and Chapter Leadership showcased our accomplishments.

Regionals/Women/India Office:

1. Regional Momentum: Four regional meetings generated significant momentum, invigorating numerous chapters.

2. Women's Empowerment: Steady progress was made in empowering women, with over 50 new female members added this year.

3. Diversity Initiatives: Our ongoing efforts to promote diversity within ITServe continue to gain traction.

4. India Office: The ITServe India Office, with over 15 operational employees, contributed significantly across various teams.

5. Team Strengthening in India: While significant progress has been made in Membership Team, Finance Team, and PR Team, there remains an imperative to further strengthen teams in CSR, PAC, Technology, and Sponsorship.

Synergy 2023:

1. Record-Breaking Synergy: Synergy 2023 was an unprecedented success, surpassing \$4 million in revenue, and achieving a remarkable 90% satisfaction rate among 190+ members surveyed.

2. Participation: With 170 Synergy Elites, 800+ Diamond Passes, and 20 Platinum Members, we upheld a high standard of excellence by not issuing free Diamond passes.

3. Smooth Execution: The flawless execution of the registration system, event layout, food arrangements, and website development was achieved well in advance.

4. Cost Control: Careful cost control measures were implemented, resulting in substantial savings of more than \$1 million.

Treasury/Secretary and Bylaws/TekWay:

1. Financial Success: We collected an impressive \$7.5 million for ITSA, efficiently implemented financial guidelines, and successfully controlled expenses. Our prudence led to the generation of a surplus of \$2 million+ from 2023 operations.

2. Transparency and Compliance: We maintained impeccable transparency, publishing minutes in a timely manner, filing annual returns, and ensuring compliance with insurance requirements.

3. Tax Returns and Audited Financials: We successfully filed combined tax returns for federal and state entities and completed audited financials for 2022.

4. Bylaws: After extensive work, final bylaws were published in September 2023. Minor amendments were introduced to address operational challenges for the 2024 team, following a thorough review by Frank Hill Law firm.

5. TekWay Victory: After a long and arduous journey spanning five presidencies, ITServe emerged victorious in the TekWay case, bringing a fitting end to this chapter.

ITServe Members Serve As Judges At The United States Congressional App Challenge Contest

Members of ITServe Alliance, the largest association of IT Services organizations across the United States, comprising of over 2200 small and medium-sized businesses were chosen to be and were part of the Judges Panel at the prestigious United States Congressional App Challenge Contest held last month.

Established by members of the U.S. House of Representatives in 2013, the Congressional App Challenge is designed to engage student creativity and encourage their participation in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) education fields. The nationwide contest allows high school students from across the country to compete with other students who reside in their congressional district by creating and exhibiting their software application, or "APP" for mobile, tablet, or computer devices on a platform of their choice.

During the event organized by Illinois's 11th Congressional District, Vinay Mahajan addressed the APP participants and congratulated the winner, a 10th grader from Illinois who developed the Dermidetect APP, a skin cancer detector using AI.

"We are extremely proud that Omprakash Nakka, Tanuj Gundlapalli, Jagan Chitiprolu, and Venkat Yerubandi, all active members of ITServe had the privilege of serving as Judges for the Congressional App Challenge Program," said Mr. Vinay Mahajan, President of ITServe Alliance. "Such contests across the nation by Congressional Offices is very encouraging of our young and aspiring entrepreneurs and is in sync with the objectives of ITServe Alliance in promoting and advocating for local talents and resources that are aimed at the United States maintaining its leadership in technology and innovation," Mahajan added.

Siva Moopanar, Director of ITServe Alliance Policy Advocacy Committee (PAC), who has been instrumental in coordinating with the Congressional Offices for ITServe's participation in the Congressional APP Challenge said, "We acknowledge that this program provides a great opportunity for us at ITServe to engage with Lawmakers and make a positive impact on our upcoming generation of innovators in Science and Technology."

ITServe recognizes that this is a great program and has plans to engage with more Congressmen for similar opportunities in the coming years. ITServe has offered allocating funds from its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) STEM Funds to support

this program by collaborating directly with the congressional App challenge organizers. ITServe has advocated for and has invested Millions of Dollars on its STEM Education Program to promote the "American Ingenuity Account" to fund State-administered grants for STEM education and worker training.

The Congressional App Challenge is sponsored by the Internet Education Foundation (IEF), which assists offices in hosting the challenges in their individual districts. - The technical moat for the business comes from several dimensions:
- Breadth: The ability to rapidly support more devices

- Conducted a session with immigration lawyers on preventing multiple registrations, sharing guidelines with members.
- Submitted a letter to House/Senate Judiciary Committee leaders about increasing the visa CAP and addressing issues with multiple registrations; also support their good initiatives.
- Educated ITServe members about the proper practices regarding H1B Multiple Registration.

Extension of Grace Period to 180 Days

- Requested the extension of the grace period for laid-off H-1B employees from 60 to 180 days in a letter to President Biden and legislators.

H1B Visa Revalidation in the US

- The U.S. Department of State has recently announced the resumption of visa renewals (H & L Categories) within the U.S. We prioritized this topic during our interactions with lawmakers during our past Capitol Hill Days and USCIS listened to ITServe.

PAC & Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)

- Invited legislators to participate in CSR initiatives and Chapter meetings.
- Projected ITServe's CSR activities with lawmakers, particularly during Capitol Hill Day. They were impressed with STEM programs.

PAC & Startup

- PAC engaged with Congress members on entrepreneurship; ITServe Startup Team judged the "Congressional Mobile App Challenge."

Cost Savings Initiatives

- Negotiated a 40% cost reduction with the government liaison office (Monte Ward) and General Counsel (Jon Wasden).

Revenue & Fundraising Changes

- Discontinued separate PAC fundraising for PAC; \$300 will be collected from each member at joining or renewal as part of ITServe membership dues.

Pioneering Pilot Program Enables In-Place Visa Renewal for Foreign H-1B Workers

In a significant development, the White House Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs has given the green light to a pilot program enabling a restricted number of foreign H-1B workers to renew their visas without the need to depart from the United States. The State Department disclosed last month that the pilot program, identified as RIN 1400-AF27, is set to kick off in January with an initial quota of 20,000 participants. However, the comprehensive details regarding eligibility criteria and the operational aspects of this initiative will only be unveiled upon the publication of a notice in the Federal Register.
