Regarding the STEM workforce, Sen. Cornyn said, "I support efforts to address gaps in the high-skilled workforce with talented, hard-working, risk-taking, ambitious individuals who want to contribute to the American dream and strengthen our local economy."

IMMIGRANT FOUNDERS POWER NEARLY HALF OF FORTUNE 500 COMPANIES IN 2025

New American Entrepreneurs Drive Innovation, Job Creation, and Economic Growth

In 2025, immigrant entrepreneurs and their children continue to shape the backbone of America's largest and most influential businesses. According to new analysis, 46.2 percent of Fortune 500 companies—231 out of 500—were founded by immigrants or the children of immigrants. This powerful group, often referred to as "New American" companies, extends across every major sector and is responsible for an outsized share of innovation, job creation, and economic activity in the United States and around the globe.

Immigrant Roots of Major Corporations

The influence of New American founders is evident in some of the most recognizable brands. General Electric (GE) traces its origins to Thomas Edison, whose father immigrated from Canada; NVIDIA, a global leader in graphics and AI, was co-founded by Jensen Huang, who moved to the U.S. from Taiwan as a child; Sirius XM, now a Fortune 500 newcomer, was shaped by Canadian-born David Margolese.

THE H-1B VISA PROGRAM: FILLING GAPS, FUELING INNOVATION, AND SHAPING THE U.S. ECONOMY

As the U.S. continues to lead in scientific and technological innovation, foreign-born professionals, especially those in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM), remain critical to the nation's workforce and economic growth.

Each year, thousands of U.S. employers seek to hire highly skilled foreign nationals through the H-1B visa program—a system that has become both a lifeline and a flashpoint in debates over immigration policy and economic competitiveness.

With demand for STEM talent soaring, the annual cap of H-1B visas set by Congress has consistently fallen short of employer needs, often being reached months before year-end. For Fiscal Year (FY) 2025, the cap was hit on December 2, 2024, highlighting the program's popularity and the persistent shortage of qualified domestic candidates in specialized fields. Research and economic data reveal that H-1B workers do not displace American workers; instead, they complement their skill sets, fill critical gaps, and help expand job opportunities across sectors.

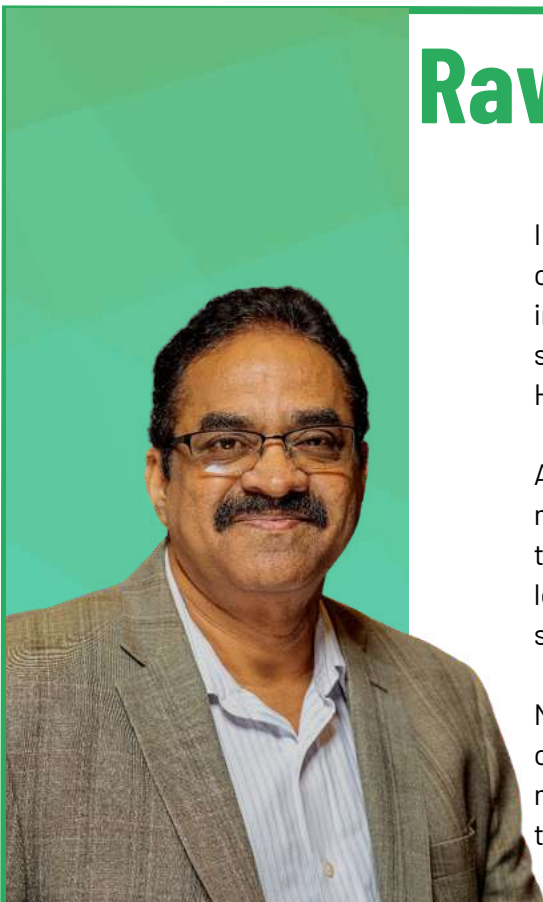

\$100,000 H-1B FEE CAUSES CHAOS, LIKELY UNAFFORDABLE FOR MANY COMPANIES



On Friday evening, September 19, 2025, a presidential proclamation panicked many U.S. businesses and H-1B workers who were outside the United States.

As written, the proclamation prohibited the entry of noncitizens to the United States in H-1B status, after 12:01 am Eastern Time on September 21, 2025 (the deadline) if the employer that had filed an H-1B petition for them had not paid a \$100,000 fee. The restriction will expire in 12 months, unless extended. The proclamation also would restrict USCIS adjudication of H-1B petitions filed on behalf of noncitizens abroad if the petitioner had not paid the fee.

A White House fact sheet issued on September 19 also said that the proclamation restricts entry for H-1B workers "unless their petition is accompanied by a \$100,000 payment."

WEIGHTED SELECTION PROCESS FOR REGISTRANTS AND PETITIONERS SEEKING TO FILE CAP-SUBJECT H-1B PETITIONS

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) proposes to amend its regulations governing the process by which U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) selects H-1B registrations for unique beneficiaries for filing of H-1B cap-subject petitions (or H-1B petitions for any year in which the registration requirement is suspended). DHS proposes to implement a weighted selection process that would generally favor the allocation of H-1B visas to higher skilled and higher paid aliens, while maintaining the opportunity for employers to secure H-1B workers at all wage levels, to better serve the Congressional intent for the H-1B program.
