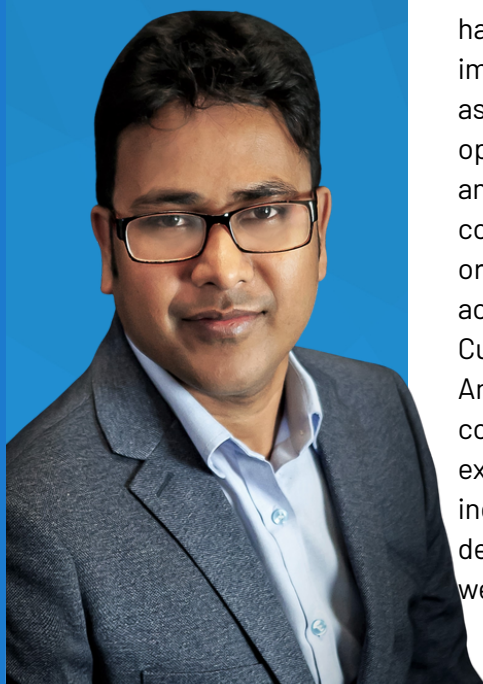

MAJOR CLARIFICATION: NEW \$100,000 FEE FOR H-1B VISAS ONLY HITS NEW OVERSEAS APPLICANTS



The U.S. Department of Homeland Security has issued a detailed clarification on the newly introduced \$100,000 H-1B visa application fee, resolving weeks of confusion among employers and visa applicants.

According to the updated guidance, the fee applies only to new H-1B petitions filed on or after September 21, 2025, specifically for beneficiaries residing outside the United States who do not currently hold valid H-1B status.

This means that **most existing H-1B visa holders** and employers filing for **extensions, amendments, or changes of employer** are **exempt** from paying the hefty amount. Similarly, individuals applying for a **change of status** within the U.S. (for instance, from F-1 student to H-1B) are also not required to pay this fee.

US ENDS AUTOMATIC EXTENSION OF WORK PERMITS

The Trump administration is removing an automatic grace period for immigrants with pending work permit renewals, a move that will force out of the workforce many people stuck in worsening administrative backlogs.

The Department of Homeland Security under the Biden administration adopted regulations giving immigrants with pending renewals of employment authorization documents an automatic extension of 540 days. They'd previously received an automatic extension period of 180 days.

US Citizenship and Immigration Services, the DHS unit that administers immigration benefits, moved to limit extensions for work permits with a recent influx of asylum seekers in mind...
